



Feature Addition 7-2009

Overview

On July 26, 2009, House Bill 1824 – also known as the Zackery Lystedt Law – becomes effective. The law mandates that ALL players and parent(s)/guardian(s) sign and return an informed consent form relating to the nature and risk of concussion or head injury. This information sheet shall include the signs and symptoms of concussion/brain injury. The new law is an important step in ensuring player safety and mitigating head injuries.

Furthermore, the law mandates that **ALL coaches** (paid or volunteer) are educated in the nature and risk of concussion or head injury <u>prior to</u> the first practice/competition. This education shall include signs and symptoms of concussion/brain injury.

How Do I Track This for My Players and Coaches

Bonzi software, in partnership with Washington Youth Soccer, has developed a new feature to help you track which players and coaches have complied with the new law. There are a new set of easy tools and reports that should make this process pretty easy.

There are two ways for players and coaches to become registered in your system: 1. Through online registration completed by the player/parent/coach and 2., if the registrar or administrator in your organization hand-enters the registration for the coach or player.

Online Registration

Bonzi has changed the software so during online registration the necessary "waiver" that meets the requirements of the new law is displayed to the player or coach/volunteer who is registering online. This waiver is NOT visible to your organization and will display automatically. Neither you nor the Bonzi staff can turn off the waiver from your registration event, however the waivers will only show for events that report to your state soccer association.

After the waiver displays to the registrant, their CCL (Concussion Compliance Law) record for the season is marked as completed. (How will you know this? See discussion further below.)

Hand Entering Registrations

If you hand-enter or manually enter registration forms for your players or coaches, they will NOT be in compliance automatically as they would if they registered online. So if you manually enter a player or coach/volunteer, the member will need to go online, log into their member account and follow the instructions provided to review and acknowledge the necessary concussion education information. You may also provide your members with a paper copy of the materials and record the receipt by your member in your software once you have the signed copy in your paper files.

How Do I Know Whether or Not My Member is In Compliance with the Law?

Bonzi has developed several tools to help you track who is and who is not in compliance with the concussion management law.






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CLUB REGISTRARS REPORTS CONT'D

Registration Form - Check Box

When you use the FIND feature to search for a player or coach, you can double-click on their record when it displays, which then displays their registration form. In the "information" section of the registration form, there is a check box that says "Agreed to the Concussion Compliance wavier". If the box is checked, the member has received and "signed" the waiver. If it's not checked, the member needs to log onto their member account and follow the directions in the notice displayed on their home page or receive and sign a paper copy of those materials prepared for you by Washington Youth Soccer. This is true for both players and coach/volunteers.



Team Settings Page

After you've rostered players and coaches to your teams, you'll now notice an extra column at the right of the roster titled CCL for Concussion Compliance Law. If the box is checked, your members are in compliance. If it's not checked, they need to log into their member account to review and acknowledge the materials necessary for compliance OR receive and sign a paper copy of those materials prepared for you by Washington Youth Soccer.

How Does "The Box" Get Checked?

The check box on the registration form and on the Team Settings page "gets checked" in one of two ways:

1.) the member logs into their member account and follows the instructions in the "notice box",

or

2.) you as the registrar or administrator may check the box on the registration form or the team settings page to indicate that your member has received the materials necessary for compliance. You many only do so if you have paper copy signed by the member on file.

There Are Also 3 New Reports

Under Reports / Registration there's a new report called Concussion Compliance and Concussion Compliance Status.

Concussion Compliance Report - This report will display all the players and coaches in your organization who are IN or OUT of compliance for the season. You can send a group email from that report reminding those members that they need to log onto their member account, receive and "electronically acknowledge" for their materials at which time they will be recorded as "in





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compliance". For a pre-written email with instructions on this, visit the concussion resource center on wsysa.com.

Concussion Compliance Status – This report will email the head coach for each team the current status of each of their players and staff members. You can select (click on) your entire registration event OR you can chose only one team if you wish. The status information is sent directly in the email so there's no attachment, decreasing the likelihood of the email being blocked.

Sample of Email-

If any of the members of your roster are not in compliance, please ask them to log onto their member account, (found on the club's web site) read and agree to the Concussion Waiver.

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CLUB REGISTRARS REPORTS CONT'D

Detailed Team Roster – Under Reports/Folders and Teams you have a Detailed Team Roster. This roster includes all information the coach needs about the team AND includes a new column indicating who is and is not in compliance with the concussion law.

You can email this roster to the coach(es) by clicking on the team itself in your folder and clicking the EMAIL ROSTER button.

Coaches can also retrieve this roster through their Coach Tools if you've given them access. This roster or the safe rosters can be printed and used as proof of compliance for tournaments and other events.

Assigning Coach Tools Access:

You can turn on Coach Tools easily for your coaches who are already rostered to a team. Simply locate the team in the folder tree and select the team. The Edit Folder and Team Settings page displays. Scroll down the page to the area where your assigned coach names are listed and beside EACH name will be a check box for Coach Tools.

Click the check box and click the UPDATE button in the middle of the page. That does a couple things for you:

- 1. Access to Coach Tools is setup for the coach using his/her member account username and password.
- 2. The coach is emailed instructions on where to log into Coach Tools, confirms their username and password to log into Coach Tools AND includes a tutorial on how to use Coach Tools, so your job is done after you click that check box!

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ASSOCIATION REGISTRARS REPORTS

Association Registrars have access to these same reports accessible by clubs (see Club Registrar Reports):

- Logging into their Bonzi software and choosing the CLUB menu option and then the club name
 OR
- 2.) For those managing their own clubs, logging into the software and running the reports from the REPORTS menu.

Association registrars can also choose ADMIN/STATE TOOLS or log into the Washington Youth Soccer State Tools software at http://sda.bonzidev.com/sda to access the following reports. These reports have a new column added that shows who is in CCL compliance and who is not. You can filter by that compliance, save your report, and email everyone on the report who is out of compliance.

Choose the following reports:

- Reports / Player / Detail
- Reports / Coach / Detail






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COACH'S REPORTS

Detailed Team Roster – Coaches can retrieve this roster through their Coach Tools if given access by their club registrar. This roster or the safe rosters can be printed and used as proof of compliance for tournaments and other events.

Accessing Coach Tools

- Log into the Bonzi software using your username and password.
- Select the team through the folder tree for which you want to use the Coach Tools.
- Click on the Detailed Roster or Safe Roster to view and/or print CCL information about players and coaching staff.

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MEMBER ACCOUNT AND THE MEMBER HOME PAGE

When your members log on, the notice displayed will explain that this is a new law that came into effect in the State of Washington. They can follow the directions in the notice to become compliant. It only takes 1 click! Furthermore, should they wish to re-print any of the materials presented, there are links in their member account under ACCOUNT OPTIONS where they can review and/or print, at any time, the parent/player or coach/volunteer materials required to be compliant with the new law
